Short manual:

1. Download the Canoo WebTest
 - a. Go to: <http://webtest.canoo.com/webtest/manual/Downloads.html>
 - b. Get build.zip (also available on ../material/tepandi/TKS/canoo)
 - c. Unpack it
2. Installation
 - a. Go to unpacked folder
 - b. Execute that: bin\webtest -f webtest.xml wt.createProject (envoking Command window from the Programs/Accessories or using Run / cmd; it may be useful to create a bat-fail)
 - c. Provide project name, e.g.: tkjs_tests
3. Run demo
 - a. Go inside your project directory
 - b. Execute that: ..\bin\webtest
 - c. Go through results in the browser
4. Look at the existing tests
 - a. Go to tests folder
 - b. Look at the -allTests.xml - this is the test suit
 - c. Look at the -googleWebTest.xml - what does it do?
5. Create simple test
 - a. Select a website and check the page title
 - b. Check that there is last revision reference on a page (verifyText)
 - c. Try opening a link on a page with a test (clickLink)
 - d. Create more tests for this page
6. More complex tests
 - a. Pick an application, eg a calculator <http://palk.crew.ee/>
 - b. Set the salary number
 - c. Calculate
 - d. Check that calculator returned real salary
 - e. Experiment with it - set checkboxes, etc.
